### **JULY 14, AT 6PM MASS, CAMBRIDGE UNIVERSITY, DOWNING COLLEGE CHOIR**

At the 6pm Mass at Our Lady of the Snows on Saturday, July 14, the world famous Downing College Choir of Cambridge University will be singing at the Mass, a Palestrina Mass, his *Missa brevis*. This exceptional choir of young men and women will be singing the Kyrie, the Gloria, Sanctus and Angus Dei as well as an anthem, Monteverdi's *Cantate Domino*. We welcome them to Woodstock and to Our Lady of the Snows. Giovanni Palestrina (1525-1594) was an Italian Renaissance composer of sacred music and the best known 16th century representative of the Roman School of musical composition. He had a lasting influence in the development of church music, and his work is often seen as the culmination of Renaissance polyphony.
